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Defendant, Tyler James Robinson, by and through undersigned counsel hereby moves this Court to order the preparation of a transcript from the sealed hearing on October 24, 2025, and, pursuant to Utah Rule of Judicial Administration 4-202.04(3) to classify the audio recording and transcription from the hearing before the Court on October 24, 2025, as “private” under Utah Rule of Judicial Administration 4-202.02(4)(CC).

This Court sealed the hearing on October 24, 2025; as such, the Court must order the transcript be prepared and the transcript and audio from the hearing are presumed to be sealed under Utah Rule of Judicial Administration 4-202.02(3)(l). However, the parties agree that the

parties should receive an audio recording of the hearing and that a transcript should be prepared. Further, the parties agree that the audio recording and the transcript should be classified as private, thereby allowing the parties to receive and utilize the transcript for the related issues to be raised in future filings and for the purposes of appeal (in accordance with the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure requiring redaction of private information in public filings).

Given the nature of the case, request for appellate review during the pendency and/or at the conclusion of the case, is a foregone conclusion. Production of and access to the transcript and audio of the October 24, 2025 hearing is therefore necessary for (1) future trial court issues to be adequately raised and argued, and (2) for appellate review of the issues argued during the October 24th hearing, and the anticipated related hearings. Balancing the need to protect the information from the hearing against the need of the parties to utilize the record of the hearing to raise and argue issues in the future, the classification of “private” is appropriate.

BASED UPON THE FOREGOING and the stipulation of the State, Mr. Robinson respectfully requests that the Court order a transcript be prepared from the sealed hearing on October 24, 2025, and classifying the transcript and hearing audio as private in the Court record.
